THIS BOOK DETAILS HOW INTEGRATION CONTRIBUTED TO SHORT-TERM STABILITY IN SOUTH SUDAN, ALLOWING THE GOVERNMENT TO OVERCOME WARTIME FACTIONALISM AND CONSOLIDATE POLITICAL-MILITARY POWER PRIOR TO THE REFERENDUM ON SELF-DETERMINATION IN 2011. IT ALSO EXAMINES HOW THE INTEGRATION PROCESS IN SOUTH SUDAN WAS FLAWED BY ITS OPEN-ENDED NATURE AND LACK OF COORDINATION WITH EFFORTS TO RIGHT-SIZE THE MILITARY AND TRANSFORM THE BROADER DEFENSE SECTOR, AND HOW THIS LED THE MILITARY TO FRAGMENT DURING PERIODS OF HEIGHTENED POLITICAL COMPETITION. FURTHERMORE, THE BOOK EXPLAINS WHY INTEGRATION ULTIMATELY FAILED IN SOUTH SUDAN, AND IDENTIFIES THE WIDER LESSONS THAT COULD BE APPLIED TO CURRENT OR FUTURE WAR-TO-PEACE TRANSITIONS. THIS BOOK WILL BE OF GREAT INTEREST TO STUDENTS OF WAR AND CONFLICT STUDIES, PEACEBUILDING, POST-CONFLICT RECONSTRUCTION, AFRICAN SECURITY ISSUES, AND INTERNATIONAL RELATIONS IN GENERAL, AS WELL AS TO PRACTITIONERS.
