Si è infatti ritenuto che potesse configurarsi come un esercizio utile in prospettiva, per adattare alla città "privata" alcune categorie analitiche tradizionalmente usate nei confronti della città pubblica. Ciò è vero, soprattutto considerando l'importanza che il tema dell'edilizia Pubblica ha avuto, in particolar modo in Europa, a partire dalle radici filantropiche, ai programmi di iniziativa pubblica nazionale e locale attraverso i quali si sono realizzate intere parti di città, fino alle più recenti – e meno diffuse – esperienze di social housing.
