He decided to dedicate his life to the struggle for freedom and equality, and joined the African National Congress (ANC), a political party that fought against apartheid, the system of

He became a lawyer, an activist, and a leader, and was arrested and imprisoned several times for his resistance and defiance. He spent 27 years in prison, most of them on Robben Island, a notorious prison island where he endured harsh conditions and isolation. He never gave up his hope and vision, and continued to inspire and mobilize his people and the world. He was released from prison in 1990, and became the first democratically elected president of South Africa in 1994. He led the country through a peaceful transition and reconciliation, and became a global icon of human rights, democracy, and peace. He received the Nobel Peace Prize in 1993, and many other honors and awards. He died on December 5, 2013, at the age of 95, leaving behind a legacy of courage, wisdom, and compassion. He is widely regarded as the father of the nation, and one of the greatest heroes of history.
