THE THEMES PRESENTED IN THE VOLUME INCLUDE AN EMPHASIS ON THE DYNAMIC NATURE OF LANGUAGE, THE RELEVANCE OF A NOTION OF VIEWPOINT IN GRAMMATICAL ANALYSIS, THE ROLE AND NATURE OF METAPHOR AND COGNITIVE BLEND, THE POSSIBILITY OF NON-DERIVATIONAL WAYS TO CAPTURE RELATIONSHIPS AMONG CONSTRUCTIONS AND THE IMPORTANCE OF LEXICAL SEMANTICS. THIS VOLUME WILL APPEAL TO A WIDE RANGE OF LINGUISTS, ECHOING THE THEME OF THE CONFERENCE - BRINGING TOGETHER TWO DIVERSE APPROACHES TO LINGUISTICS.

Studies in Ditransitive Constructions ANDRE L VOVICH MAL CHUKOV 2010 EXPLORES THE CROSS-LINGUISTIC VARIATION IN DITRANSITIVE CONSTRUCTIONS, SYNTACTIC PATTERNS OF 'GIVE'-LIKE VERBS TAKING AGENT, THEME AND RECIPIENT ARGUMENTS. THIS VOLUME INCLUDES A TYPOLOGICAL OVERVIEW OF DITRANSITIVE CONSTRUCTIONS, THE EDITORS' QUESTIONNAIRE, AS WELL AS STUDIES OF DITRANSITIVE CONSTRUCTIONS IN LANGUAGES FROM ALL OVER THE WORLD.

LINDA WHEELDON 2000 PRESENTS THE READER WITH A PICTURE OF THE BREADTH OF CURRENT RESEARCH IN THE FIELD. CHAPTERS INVESTIGATE ALL LEVELS OF THE LANGUAGE PRODUCTION SYSTEM AND DRAWS LINKS BETWEEN DIFFERENT APPROACHES TO LANGUAGE RESEARCH.

METONYMY AND METAPHOR IN GRAMMAR KLAUS-UWE PANTHER 2009 WITH THE ADVENT OF COGNITIVE LINGUISTICS, METONYMY AND METAPHOR ARE NOW RECOGNIZED AS BEING NOT ONLY ORNAMENTAL RHETORICAL TROPES BUT FUNDAMENTAL FIGURES OF THOUGHT THAT SHAPE, TO A CONSIDERABLE EXTENT, THE CONCEPTUAL STRUCTURE OF LANGUAGES. THE PRESENT VOLUME GOES EVEN BEYOND THIS INSIGHT TO PROPOSE THAT GRAMMAR ITSELF IS METONYMICAL IN NATURE (LANGACKER) AND THAT CONCEPTUAL METONYMY AND METAPHOR LEAVE THEIR IMPRINTS ON LEXICOGRAMMATICAL STRUCTURE.
