but does not specify an algorithm for solving it. Search

answer set solvers. Combinatorial search problems often

arise in science and technology, and ASP has found

applications in diverse areas—in historical linguistic,

in bioinformatics, in robotics, in space exploration, in

oil and gas industry, and many others. The importance of
